### Notes from the Pastor

Hi, it's me again.

The teachings and examples of Jesus, show us

how we are to live so that we might come to share eternal life with him in heaven. So I guess we can answer the lawyer in today's gospel.

... but he goes on, he wants this really pinned down; Who is my neighbor? Who must I love? The Samaritans despised by many does not question, "Is this my neighbor, does he live on my street, or does he go to my church?" Jesus told the lawyer and us, "Go and do the same, do what the Samaritan did." He was not afraid to get his hand's dirty to help another human being in need.

The Samaritan placed the value of the victim above legal observances, rather than finding an excuse in the law to avoid the often messy job of helping others.

Someone said, "Neighborliness is not a quality in other people, it is simply their claim on ourselves."

A little girl told her father that some made traps to catch birds, she then told her father that she prayed that the traps would not work. But her father said, "What did you do about it?" She said, "Well when they were not looking, I kicked the traps to pieces." Sometimes, we have to get messy and kick the traps to pieces.

At the same time, we need to show mercy to ourselves. Sometimes we don't respond as we should. As a dear friend reminded me, some time ago, "You are only human." So we try again, why not now, why not today.

## ParishPay

Automated giving is a voluntary program available now which can be used to support the parish instead of envelopes. In lieu of weekly collections, the ParishPay program will collect monthly contributions from your checking, savings, or credit card account. There is **NO** cost or binding contract to participate in the program.

### What are the benefits to me and the parish?

- Allows you to plan your giving, in the same way you budget your other financial commitments. Just take your annual contribution and divide it by 12 to calculate your monthly offering (Weekly contribution times 52, divided by 12).
- You don't have to be concerned about catching-up missed offertory donations when you miss a Mass because you are out of town, ill, etc.
- You can easily adjust the amount of your automated contribution (up or down) through the Rectory or via a secure website access.
- You no longer need to write a check every week or worry about forgetting your envelope and your collection being properly credited.
- You can earn points and/or mileage on your credit card.
- You will receive an accurate year end report for tax purposes.
- If you choose to participate in the Automated Giving Program, this will replace your weekly envelopes, saving the parish printing costs.
- Special *donation* slips are available for those enrolled in the automated giving program that can be dropped into the collection basket, should you wish.
- You can specify your giving level for Second Collections and other celebration dates (e.g., Christmas, Easter) when you join the Automated Giving Program, or anytime thereafter.
