Hi, it's me again.

I am so grateful for all our staff, parish committees for what they have done over the year, and as I said last week, I likewise am grateful for Msgr. Cox's presence with us again.

During this month, we will also have Fr. Emilio Rosolen from Cross International Catholic Outreach. The Society of the Propagation of Faith will send us Fr. Russell Becker, a Franciscan from Tokyo, Japan. Both will share with us the needs of people across our world.

Let our faith be firm that we may be prepared to stand before the Lord and know his peace.

Our readings today point out the necessity of trusting faith in God's promises.

Be vigilant and ready to face the Lord. We need to pray, Lord teach us to pray. An important element in prayers is listening to God—an attitude of attention to the tiny whispering sound of the Lord (Kings 19:11-12). So we need to set aside a quiet time every day during which we can tune our ears to the divine sounds of love, harmony, and peace. 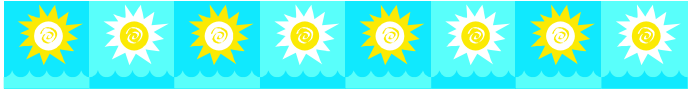
Can you commit 1 Sunday a month for 2 hours to assist in counting the collection? We could really use your help. Please call the rectory for details.

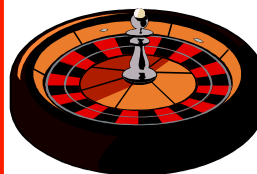

The Adult Learning Center of Rockland is an organization of retired Seniors who volunteer to teach other Seniors (and over 50s) how to use computers. We are affiliated with Meals on Wheels.

We are now accepting applications for our September classes.

Classes are 2 hours, once a week for 4 weeks at a cost of \$40.00 for the course. More advanced classes are for 8 weeks at a cost of \$64.00.

We teach Introduction to Computers, Word Processing, Quicken, Internet and E-mail, Digital Imaging and Genealogy.

Classes are small - only 8 students per class, with 1 instructor and 2 coaches.

ParishPay

Automated giving is a voluntary program available now which can be used to support the parish instead of envelopes. In lieu of weekly collections, the ParishPay program will collect monthly contributions from your checking, savings, or credit card account. There is NO cost or binding contract to participate in the program.

What are the benefits to me and the parish?

- Allows you to plan your giving, in the same way you budget your other financial commitments. Just take your annual contribution and divide it by 12 to calculate your monthly offering (Weekly contribution times 52, divided by 12).
- You don't have to be concerned about catching-up missed offertory donations when you miss a Mass because you are out of town, ill, etc.
- You can easily adjust the amount of your automated contribution (up or down) through the Rectory or via a secure website access.
- You no longer need to write a check every week or worry about forgetting your envelope and your collection being properly credited.
- You can earn points and/or mileage on your credit card.
- You will receive an accurate year end report for tax purposes.
- If you choose to participate in the Automated Giving Program, this will replace your weekly envelopes, saving the parish printing costs.
- Special *donation* slips are available for those enrolled in the automated giving program that can be dropped into the collection basket, should you wish.
- You can specify your giving level for Second Collections and other celebration dates (e.g., Christmas, Easter) when you join the Automated Giving Program, or anytime thereafter.
